Ad 1) Opening

Prof. Patrick Van Damme, the Chairman, opened the Scientific Board meeting at 10:00 a.m.

Ad 2) Reflection on Previous SB Meeting

Prof. Patrick Van Damme, the Chairman, informed the audience of the content of the last SB meeting (10th of December 2021): Successful commencement of professorship procedure of doc. Mgr. Jan Šobotník Ph.D., approval of new members of Doctoral Degree Board.

Ad 3) Introducing strategic plan FTA 2022

Prof. Patrick Van Damme, the Chairman, presented FTA's Annual report for 2021. This report consists of areas of activity arranged according to the Ministry of Education's guidelines. In particular, the following points were highlighted and discussed:

- Increasing number of students and academic staff
- Internationalization of the FTA
- Training of pedagogical skills of academic staff
- Overview of projects and budgets
- Implementation of educational programs (Researchers Night, Week of Science...)
- FTA participation in the implementation of international research projects

Ad 4) Habilitation procedure of Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D.

Prof. Ing. Jan Banout, Ph.D. briefly introduced Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D.

Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D., presented her habilitation thesis titled: "Use of Analytical Techniques for the Determination of Natural Substances from Plants and Insects" within recommended 20 minutes. Prof. Dr. Ing. Eloy Fernández Cusimamani, chairman of the habilitation committee, presented the report of the habilitation committee. Subsequently, opponents of the habilitation thesis - Ing. Dalibor Titěra, CSc., prof. RNDr. Jan Žďárek, DrSc., and doc. Ing. Kateřina Valentová, Ph.D., presented their respective opponent reviews. Ing. Klára

Urbanová, Ph.D. answered the questions raised by the reviewers, followed by a more general discussion involving the public.

Subsequently, Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D. presented her education presentation titled: "Basic Overview of Food Preservation" where she show-cased her teaching ability. The following members took the floor in the debate: prof. RNDr. Irena Valterová, CSc., doc. RNDr. Pavlína Maloy Řezáčová, Ph.D., doc. Ing. Jan Chyský, CSc. Prof. Ing. Jan Banout, Ph.D. proposed Pavlína Maloy Řezáčová, Ph.D. and prof. Ing. Bohdan Lojka, Ph.D. as scrutineers for the vote's results: 16 members in favour, 0 members against, 2 abstentions. The Scientific Board (total number of SB members 21, present 18) voted to nominate Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D. as associate professor - doc. with the following result: 17 members in favour, 1 member against, 0 abstentions.

<u>Conclusion:</u> The Scientific Board approved Ing. Klára Urbanová, Ph.D. as associate professordoc. at FTA, CZU Prague.

Ad 5) Approval of the new examiners for state doctoral exams and committees for Bachelor and Master state examination and defenses.

The Scientific Board (total number of SB members 21, present 18) examined all submitted documents and approved the new examiners for state doctoral exams and committees for bachelor and master state examination and defenses with the following result: 18 members in favour, 0 member against, 0 abstentions.

Ad 6) Miscellaneous

Approval of the new members of TABM, ATS Doctoral Degree Boards

Prof. Patrick Van Damme, the Chairman, briefly introduced Ing. Martin Kulma, Ph.D. and prof. Lukáš Kratochvíl, Ph.D. Subsequently, there was a public vote on the proposal of new members of TABM, ATS DDB with as result: 18 members in favour, 0 member against, 0 abstentions.
