

Determination of the amount of the fee for study in a foreign language at the Faculty of Tropical Agriculture for the academic year 2025/2026

Article 1

Introductory provisions

- (1) This Dean's Regulation is valid for the Faculty of Tropical Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as "Faculty") of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU") and sets the amount of the fee for studying in a foreign language.
- (2) This Regulation is prepared in accordance with Act No.111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and Article 25 of the Statute of the Czech University of Agriculture in Prague (hereinafter referred to as "the Statute").

Article 2

Determination of the amount of the fee for studying in a foreign language

- (1) The amount of the fee for study in a study programme conducted in a foreign language pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Act (hereinafter referred to as the "fee for study in a foreign language") is determined taking into account, in particular, the economic demands of the study, the costs of ensuring the quality of the study and the current situation in a similar field of education:

- (3) The fee for students who are in their 5th year of study in the Bachelor's degree programme International Cooperation in Agricultural and Rural Development is increased to CZK 40 000 for each year of study. This time includes studies in other bachelor programmes in the Czech Republic, which have been completed otherwise than in a proper manner.
- (4) The fee for students who are in their 4th year of study in a Master's programme other than Tropical Farming Systems and Tropical Agroecology is increased to CZK 40 000 for each year of study. This includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic, which have been completed other than in a proper manner.
- (5) The fee for students who are already in their 4th year of study in the Tropical Farming Systems Master's programme is CZK 60 000 for each year of study. This time includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic, which have been completed other than in a proper manner.
- (6) The fee for students who are already in their 4th year of study in the Master's programme Tropical Agroecology remains at CZK 110 000 for each year of study. This includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic that have been completed other than in a proper manner.
- (7) The decision on the assessment of the fee for study in a foreign language pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Article shall be issued by the dean or the vice-dean of the faculty authorised by the dean, and the fee shall be payable before the date of

enrolment in the study or before the date of enrolment in the higher year of study. The fee for study in a foreign language is non-refundable.

- (8) When paying the fee for studying in a foreign language, the student must correctly fill in the specific and variable symbol of the payment according to the data provided in the University Information System. Bank charges are the responsibility of the student.
- (9) The dean or the vice-dean authorized by the dean may reduce the amount of the fee up to the level of the fee that was in effect in the academic year in which the student was enrolled. In accordance with Section 68(3) of the Act, the issuance of a decision under this paragraph is the first act in the proceedings.

Article 3

Final provisions

- (1) This regulation was discussed in the College of the Dean of FTZ on 5 June 2024.
- (2) This regulation was approved by the FTZ Academic Senate on 12 June 2024.
- (3) This Regulation shall enter into force and effect on the date of its promulgation.
