Determination of tuition fees for studies in a foreign language at the Faculty of Tropical AgriSciences for the academic year 2026/2027

Article 1

Introductory provisions

- (1) This Regulation is applicable to the Faculty of Tropical AgriSciences (hereinafter referred to as "the Faculty") of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague (hereinafter referred to as "the CZU") and sets the amount of the fee for study in a foreign language at the Faculty for the academic year 2026/2027.
- (2) This Regulation is prepared in accordance with Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Additions to Other Acts (the Higher Education Act), as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and Article 25 of the Statute of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague (hereinafter referred to as "the Statute").
- (3) The tuition fees under this Regulation shall apply to students who commence their studies in degree programmes taught in English in the academic year 2026/2027 and shall be valid for the standard duration of their studies plus one year. Students who started their studies in English-language programmes before that academic year shall be subject to the fees set out in the previous internal regulation in force on the date of their enrolment.

Article 2

Determination of tuition fees for studies in a foreign language

- (1) Tuition fee for studies in a study programme conducted in a foreign language pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Act (hereinafter referred to as the "foreign language fee") shall be determined taking into account, in particular, the economic demands of the study, the costs of ensuring the quality of the study and the current situation in a similar field of education as follows:

Doctoral	All doctoral programmes in a foreign language except Agriculture in Tropics and Subtropics	8 000	8 000
Doctoral	Agriculture in Tropics and Subtropics	80 000	80 000

(2) The fee for students referred to in Article 1, paragraph 3, sentence 1 of this Regulation who are already in their 5th year of study in the Bachelor's degree programme International Cooperation in Agricultural and Rural Development shall be increased to 40 000 CZK for each year of study. This includes studies in other bachelor programmes in the Czech Republic which have been completed otherwise than in a proper manner.

(3) The fee for students referred to in Article 1, paragraph 3, sentence 1 of this Regulation who are in their fourth year of study in a Master's degree programme other than Tropical Farming Systems and Tropical Agroecology shall be increased to CZK 40 000 for each

year of study. This includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic which have been completed other than in a proper manner.

- (4) The fee for students referred to in Article 1, paragraph 3, sentence 1 of this Regulation who are already in their fourth year of study in the Master's degree programme Tropical Farming Systems shall be CZK 60 000 for each year of study. This period also includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic, which have been completed otherwise than in a proper manner.
- (5) The fee for students referred to in Article 1, paragraph 3, sentence 1 of this Regulation who are already in their 4th year of study in the Master's programme in Tropical Agroecology shall remain at CZK 110,000 for each year of study. This period includes studies in other Master's programmes in the Czech Republic which have been completed other than in a proper manner.
- (6) The decision on the assessment of the fee for study in a foreign language pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Article shall be issued by the dean or the vice-dean of the faculty authorised by the dean, and the fee shall be payable before the date of enrolment in the study or before the date of enrolment in the higher year of study. For students referred to in Article 1, paragraph 3, sentence 1 of this Regulation, the non-refundable part of the fee shall be CZK 8 000 if the student does not enrol.
- (7) When paying the foreign language tuition fee, the student must correctly fill in the specific and variable symbol of the payment according to the data provided in the University Information System. Bank charges are to be paid by the student.

Article 3 **Final provisions**

- (1) This regulation was discussed in the College of the Dean of the FTZ on 4 June 2025.
- (2) This Regulation was approved by the Academic Senate of the FTZ on 26 June 2025.
- (3) This Regulation shall enter into force and effect on the date of its promulgation.
