The FTZ Academic Senate announces elections to the Academic Senate of the Faculty of Tropical Agriculture (FTZ AS) in the student and faculty staff constituencies of the FTZ

for the constituency: Faculty of Tropical Agriculture (FTZ)

Pursuant to Article 7, Paragraph 2 of the AS FTZ Election Rules, the AS FTZ established an Election Commission for the AS FTZ elections on April 14, 2026, with the following composition.

Members of the Election Commission:

- Ing. Miroslav Mulko (Member of the Commission, Students constituency)
- Bc. Mikuláš Středa (Member of the Commission, Students constituency)

Pursuant to Article 6, Paragraph 3, this Election Committee hereby announces elections to the FTZ AS on April 15, 2026, for the student and academic staff constituencies of the FTZ electoral district, with the following election schedule:

April 27–28, 2026 Nomination of Candidates

- On the dates listed above, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., written nominations for representatives to the FTZ AS for the “Students” and “Academic Staff” constituencies of the FTZ may be submitted in accordance with the FTZ AS Election Rules. Candidate nominations must be submitted on the nomination forms available on the FTZ website <https://www.ftz.czu.cz/cs/r-6855-o-fakulte/r-6862-akademicky-senat> and on the FTZ bulletin board on the ground floor. Nomination forms and two ballot boxes for marked nominations, one for each FTZ AS electoral district, will be located on the 4th floor of the FTZ building in the Dean’s Secretariat office (Ms. Janíková, NFTZ/Room 407).

April 29 – May 5, 2026 Candidate Statements

- Nominated candidates will be contacted by the Election Commission via their student or employee emails (or via the phone number listed on the nomination form) to express their consent or objection to the candidacy, and the candidate must confirm this with their handwritten signature. By this deadline, candidates must also submit their biographies for publication.

May 7, 2026 Announcement of Candidates

- A list and brief profiles of the nominated candidates for representatives in the FTZ AS who have agreed to stand for election will be published on the FTZ website and on the FTZ bulletin board on the ground floor.

May 22 and May 25, 2026 FTZ AS Elections

- The elections will take place on May 22 and May 25, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. in Room 403 on the 4th floor of the FTZ building.
- Students may vote for the nominated candidates in the “FTZ Students” electoral district, i.e., students currently enrolled or those who have received a decision of admission to a master’s program at FTZ. Three representatives from among FTZ students will be elected for the “FTZ Students” electoral district.
- All employees with an academic-type position at FTZ are eligible to vote in the “FTZ Academic Staff” electoral district. Six representatives are elected from among FTZ academic staff for the “FTZ Academic Staff” electoral district.
- Ballots will be distributed by the election committee immediately before the election in the polling station. Voters shall mark on the ballot exactly as many candidates as there are members of the FTZ AS in their constituency.
- If the same person is a member of the FTZ Academic Community as a student and is also an academic staff member, that person must decide whether to use the right to vote and be elected as a student or academic staff member.

May 25, 2026 Announcement of Election Results

- After the election concludes, the Election Committee will open the ballot box, count the votes for each candidate, and announce the election results in accordance with the FTZ AS Election Rules.
