Schedule for the Election of Representatives to the Academic Senate of CZU Prague

for the term of office from December 2026 to November 2029 for FTZ.

On 17 June 2026, the Academic Senate of FTZ approved by resolution the following schedule for the elections to the CZU Academic Senate for the electoral constituencies of FTZ academic staff and FTZ students.

14- 15 October 2026 **Candidate Nominations**

- Candidate nominations must be submitted on nomination forms published on the FTZ website:
<https://www.ftz.czu.cz/cs/r-6855-o-fakulte/r-6862-akademicky-senat>
Nomination forms must be placed in the designated box located on the 4th floor of the FTZ building, Room No. 407 (Markéta Janíková), between 10:00 and 12:00 and between 13:00 and 15:00. FTZ students nominate FTZ students. FTZ academic staff nominate FTZ academic staff.

19- 30 October 2026 **Candidates' Statements**

- Nominated candidates will be contacted by the electoral committee via their student or employee e-mail addresses and by telephone using the number provided on the nomination form, in order to state whether they accept or decline their candidacy. Their decision must be confirmed by their handwritten signature. During this period, candidates must also submit their presentations to the Sub-Electoral Committee for publication.

2 November 2026 **Announcement of Candidates**

- The names and presentations of the candidates will be published on the FTZ website and on the FTZ notice board on the ground floor.

6- 9 November 2026 **Elections to the CZU Academic Senate**

- The elections to the CZU Academic Senate will take place on both days from 10:00 to 15:00 in the FTZ building, Room No. 315 (meeting room on the 3rd

floor). In the “FTZ Students” electoral constituency, 2 representatives are elected from among FTZ students. In the “FTZ Academic Staff” electoral constituency, 3 representatives are elected from among FTZ academic staff. Voters may mark no more candidates on the ballot paper than the number of CZU Academic Senate members elected in their constituency. If the same person is a member of the CZU academic community both as a student and as an academic staff member, that person must decide whether to exercise the right to vote and stand for election as a student or as an academic staff member.

by 10 November 2026 Publication of Election Results

- After voting has ended, the electoral committee will unseal the ballot boxes and count the votes cast for the individual candidates. The Sub-Electoral Committee will evaluate the election results no later than the day following the final day of voting. The Chair of the Sub-Electoral Committee, or a member of the Sub-Electoral Committee authorised by the Chair, will immediately submit the established election results for the relevant electoral constituency to the Main Electoral Committee and ensure their publication.
