	language spoken is Korean and all the staff members speak Korean.
	*Dormitory Fee= 684,000KRW / Semester (about \$560, 560EUR)
Living Conditions	*3-4 students share a room
	*Furniture include beds, desks, bookshelves, closets in each room
	*Facilities: shower stalls, latrines, laundry room, lounge
	*Only International dorm has a kitchen where students can cook meals.
Settlement fee	Text books= approx. 200,000 KRW (\$200, 200EUR)
