

# Registration for Studies within the Programme ERASMUS+ in Europe in ac. year 2022/2023



You can register for the study exchange programme Erasmus+ by uploading of the documents mentioned below by 11.2.2022, 23:59, to [https://1url.cz/@Erasmus\\_Apps](https://1url.cz/@Erasmus_Apps).

- **Summary** (name, surname, e-mail address, country and name of the university, which you want to apply for, preferred semester for which you want to apply)
- **Transcript of study records** (from UIS, and/or Diploma Supplement) + **study average**
- **Motivation letter** in English (+ in language of instruction at the host university)
- **Language certificate** (language of instructions at the host university, not needed for native speakers) – *can be submitted later*
- **Agreement** (confirmation) of your **thesis supervisor** (the form available at the webpages of the faculty in “Erasmus+” section; may be substituted by e-mail confirmation) – *can be submitted later*

**Interview in the language of instruction** at the host university, AND also in the **official language of the host country** in most cases are part of the selection procedure. **Interviews** will take place **in February**, according to the current situation online or in person, you will get an invitation on time.

**Important** – registration is possible only to **1 university** (it’s allowed to have another 1 as “back-up” in case of lack capacity).

- ✓ We also want to **encourage PhD students**, who can register for Erasmus+ study stay and use this period as an international internship (3 months as minimum).
- ✓ In case you’ve already passed Erasmus study stay, **YOU CAN REGISTER AGAIN!!** (up to 12 months of financial support from the Erasmus+ programme in one study cycle)
