In this position, you will develop policy and legislation, implement and manage existing legislation and carry out regulatory tasks, including risk assessment, as well as monitor trade agreements.

Additionally, you must be proficient in 2 official EU languages, one at minimum C1 level and the other at minimum B2 level.
