The call for fellowships is expected to open 18 May. The MSCA-PF is a two-year postdoc training program in which you will develop the skills and competencies necessary to start an independent research career. - Cryptographically strong S-boxes (with prof. Tsonka Baycheva)
- *Combinatorics and finite geometry related to coding theory and cryptography* (*with prof. Svetlana Topalova and/or assoc. prof. Stela Zhelezova*)
- *Finite geometries and their applications to coding theory* (*with prof. Ivan Landjev*)

Outstanding candidates may be offered a post-doc position regardless of project funding or a position covered by other funding mechanisms.

Fondazione Italiana Fegato ONLUS - Italian Liver Foundation - is a non-profit organization created in 2008, which primarily involved in the field of **molecular research applied to the liver and its diseases** (*Translational Hepatology*). FIF actively interacts with several national and international scientific organizations.

The main current research lines are:

- Bilirubin in neurological damage including bilirubin-induced neurological damage in neonatal hyperbilirubinemia
- Bilirubin as modulating molecule in metabolic disorders (obesity, diabetes) and degenerative neurological disease (Parkinson and Alzheimer)
- Hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC)
- Non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD)

FIF provides a truly translational research approach, going from cells (line and primary culture) to *ex vivo* (organotypic cultures) and *in vivo* models (clinical samples). *In silico*, genetic, epigenetic, and proteomic approaches to the study of the diseases, the identifications of diagnostic markers, and therapeutic approaches are the key topic of FIF.

In 2020, the scientific production of the Italian Liver Foundation was 35 full papers, 21 reviews, and 2 book chapters. The total Impact Factor was 287, 2.

FIF is strongly committed in international partnerships to launch joint projects both in scientific and clinical settings. Currently, there are different active agreements with research centers and universities from Brazil, the Philippines, Indonesia, Mexico, USA, and Vietnam. In Europe, scientific collaboration is active with the Czech Republic, The Netherlands, Austria, France, and Portugal.

FIF hosts PhD and post-doctoral students, international fellow researchers, and undergraduate students from University.

FIF offers the opportunity to act as a host institution for **Marie Sklodowska-Curie Fellowships (MSCA) Postdoctoral Fellowships**, which are awarded by the European Commission. FIF is looking for outstanding researchers wishing to apply under the call for applications MSCA 2021-22. Fellows must be **postdoctoral researchers** (at the date of the call deadline, they have a doctoral degree). They must comply with the **mobility rule**: they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Italy for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline. At the call deadline, researchers must have **a maximum of 8 years full-time equivalent experience in research**, measured from the date that the researcher was in a possession of a doctoral degree and certified by appropriate documents.
