It is one of eight public Universities in B&H and the only one where Croatian is used as the official language. The University is founded by cantons in which the Croatian people are dominant. It consists of 10 faculties and the Academy of Fine Arts. The University of Mostar is a public HEI with an enrolment of about 12 000 students and offering more than 140 BA, MA and PhD degrees which are open to exchange students.
